The first hour we spend enjoying a meal together and talking around tables in the Hope Room and then the second hour, we will break out into various small groups. We have a number of exciting small group options for you to choose from...

How to Be Perfect

This group will study the Old Testament book of Leviticus, best known for a dizzying array of commandments that Christians selectively follow or ignore altogether. Our quest will be to "live levitically" for the season of Lent-- we will study together, encourage each other, laugh and share as we go. Join us in this bold experiment to "be perfect" according to the Law, and have your faith strengthened as we learn together. Led by Pastor Dave.

Making a Home for Faith

This series is based loosely on Elizabeth Caldwell's book by the same name. This is an opportunity for those who are interested to gather (with or without children) and talk about nurturing children in the life of faith. Led by Megan Backman, Meg Walker and Lisa Watermulder.

Taize Worship

Taize features simple prayer songs, often based on Scripture, and sung many times over. The simplicity and repetition allows the text and melody to seep deep into our souls which can help praying become as intimate and natural as breathing, in an experience that is at once profoundly individual and movingly communal. This group will practice the prayer songs, share our reactions, refine our style, and end each evening with a Taize Service. The culmination of this experience will be a joint Maundy Thursday Taize service with the Calvin Presbyterian Church. Led by Tom Ward.
